Kind attention to the references cited.

During the review meeting held on 29.06.2026, it was decided that all pending claims relating to the New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 (Employees) and the New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 (Pensioners) shall be disposed of expeditiously through the District Level Empowered Committee (DLEC).

Accordingly, it is requested to convene the District Level Empowered Committee (DLEC) meetings immediately in coordination with the District Treasury Officer concerned and ensure the following:

1. **All claims received till date**, including cases arising out of Court orders/directions, shall invariably be placed before the DLEC for consideration and disposal.

2. **All claims received on time and pending claims pertaining to the period up to 31.05.2026** under the New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 and the New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 shall be completely placed before the DLEC and finalized **on or before 31.07.2026**, without fail.
3. **All claims pertaining to the period up to 30.06.2026** under the New Health Insurance Scheme, 2021 and the New Health Insurance Scheme, 2022 shall be completely placed before the DLEC and finalized **on or before 31.08.2026**, without fail.
4. No claim shall be kept pending beyond the above time limit.
5. The Joint Director of Health Services and the District Treasury Officer shall closely coordinate and ensure completion of the DLEC process within the prescribed schedule. The Personal Assistant (Accounts) to the District Collector shall act as the Nodal Officer at the District Collectorate to coordinate the DLEC meetings.
6. Claims recommended under Scenario III & IV(TNMAR) shall be sent to this Directorate along with the TNMAR recommendation within 45 days of completion of DLEC meeting.
7. The Claims for the period upto 30.6.2026 has to be classified according to the existing scenarios [I, II, III, IV (UIC) & IV(TNMAR)].
8. The Scenarios described in ref 3rd & 4th Cited - Annexure A - Clause 16(14) has to be followed for claims under NHIS 2026 (Hospital admission from 01.07.2026) only.

The above instructions shall be treated as **Most Urgent**, and strict adherence to the timelines is requested.
